

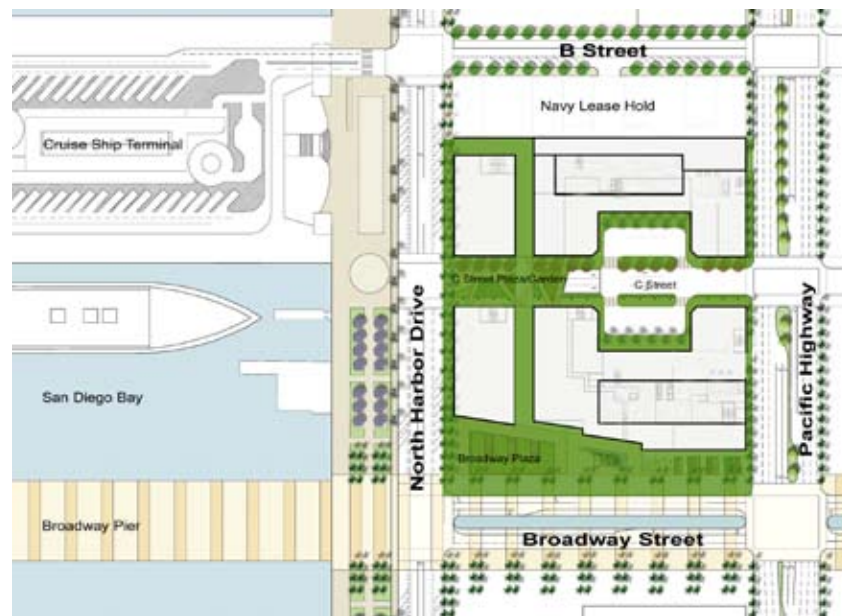

San Diego, California



A 5.8-acre property on San Diego Bay will be transformed from parking lots to a generously landscaped retail, restaurant, and entertainment development, with 250 luxury executive suites and a 550-room InterContinental Hotel. Plans recently approved by the Port of San Diego will allow the redevelopment of the former Lane Field site for the accommodation of residents, vacationers, and day visitors. Under the plans, C Street will be converted into a pedestrian promenade that opens toward the harbor and its expansive views. In addition, a 100-foot-wide esplanade along the water – a true waterfront park – will be created by moving Harbor

Drive 70 feet to the east. The plans conform to the North Embarcadero Visionary Plan, which calls for infrastructure improvement and aesthetic enhancements in bayfront redevelopments.

Sofitel JJ Oriental Hotel  
Shanghai, China



This new 400,000-square-foot hotel tower will be linked to an existing hotel through an Oriental garden, with water features and regional landscaping features. While linked to the original structure, the new building will include full-service facilities, including 450 rooms and suites, a restaurant and bar, an executive lounge, and meeting and ballroom spaces. Together, the buildings will form a five-star hotel property in Shanghai's burgeoning Pudong district,

overlooking Century Park. The opening is scheduled for 2008, in time for travelers to the Olympics in Beijing. JWDA won the commission through an invited international design competition.
